Recipe

Roasted Brussel Sprouts

Servings: 5

Ingredients:

1 ¾ pounds Brussel sprouts
3 TBSP. olive oil
½ tsp each salt and white pepper(optional)
2 TBSP. Honey

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 400 degrees

Cut thin layer from bottom stem of the Brussel sprouts if lightly browned.

Keep very small Brussel sprouts whole, half others. Remove stray leaves.

Place on a rimmed 18x13 inch baking sheet, toss with olive oil and season with salt and pepper.

Roast in oven, tossing once halfway through, until golden brown and tender, about 20-25 minutes. If they haven't browned as much as you like, move rack closer to broiler and broil briefly 20-30 seconds, watch carefully not to over brown.

In a small bowl whisk together the balsamic vinegar and honey.

Pour roasted sprouts into serving bowl, drizzle balsamic mixture and toss. Serve warm. ENJOY!
