Recipe

Tasty Vegan Potato Layer Pie

Ingredients:

10 potatoes scrubbed (with skin)
1 medium onion thinly sliced
1/2 bulb of fresh garlic thinly sliced
Pink salt and white pepper
16 oz vegetable broth
Olive oil

Directions:

Slice potatoes using slicer on food processor (you don't want them paper thin, but thin). Slice garlic thin, slice onion thin (you have rings of onions). Start by preheating oven to 325 degrees using a baking dish, spray with olive oil then start layering with the potatoes, place potatoes close together, then add onion, add garlic, sprinkle with pink salt, pepper, repeat layers to at least 3 layers. Then pour vegetable broth over all the potatoes, cover with foil, and bake for 1 hour. Check if done by piercing with a fork, if not, cook until soft. Take off foil, increase temp to 400 degrees, spray with oil, cook another 20 minutes or so until potatoes are brown. The sauce will thicken as it cooks and cools down.
