Recipe

Vegan BBQ Sandwich using Soy Curls

18 oz. Bag of Soy Curls

2 tbls. Vegan McKays chicken seasoning

2 recipes of BBQ Sauce

6-8 Buns

Directions: Break soy curls in pieces before soaking (this is easier than cutting them after soaking).

Mix chicken seasoning with enough hot water to cover soy curls in a medium bowl for rehydrating soy curls. Soak for 10 minutes. Drain soy curls and then add BBQ sauce. Cook over medium heat stirring frequently until heated. Serve on buns with coleslaw (optional on bun or just a side dish).

BBQ sauce 1 recipe

1 cup Ketchup

1 tbls. maple syrup

1 tbls. apple cider vinegar

1 1/2 tsp. liquid smoke

1 tsp. onion powder

Directions: Combine all ingredients in a medium bowl and whisk together.

Can keep refrigerated in an airtight container for 7-10 days.
