Recipe

No Bake Cherry Cream Cheese Dessert

3/4 cup graham cracker crumbs

2 tbs. unsalted butter or margarine, melted

2 tbs. sugar

1 pinch salt

1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened

1 (14 ounce) can sweetened condensed milk

1/2 cup lemon juice

1 tsp. vanilla extract

1 (21 ounce) can cherry pie filling

Directions:

Combine cracker crumbs, butter, sugar, and salt in a bowl until all ingredients are mixed together well. Divide graham cracker mixture between 8 dessert dishes, about 2 tbs of mixture per dessert dish.

Beat cream cheese in a separate bowl with an electric mixer until smooth. Gradually add sweetened condensed milk and beat in until well blended. Beat in lemon juice and vanilla. Spoon 1/4 cup of cream cheese mixture into each dish on top of graham crackers. Top with 1/4 cup cherry pie filling.

Serve immediately or chill until ready to serve.
