Recipe

Vegetarian Chicken Tater Tot Casserole

1 tbls. plant based butter or olive oil

1/2 onion chopped, more if you like onions (I used a whole small onion)

3 cups soy curls soaked in McKay's chicken season (mix hot water with McKay's, I used 3-4 tbls Mckay's seasoning with 1 cup hot water).

2 cans celery soup, mixed with the broth off the Mckay's, about 1/2 cup more if you think it's too thick when you mix all the ingredients together.

Salt and white pepper or black (optional), I used about a tsp.

1 - 12 oz bag of frozen mixed vegetables (carrots, corn, peas, green beans, etc.)

1 - 32 oz frozen bag of tater tots

Directions:

Sauté onions in butter or olive oil, just until clear not browned. Then add all other ingredients mix well. Pour into sprayed 9x13 casserole dish, top with tater tots (I usually have 2 tots left ha, ha). Bake at 425 degrees for about 30 minutes or until bubbly and tots browned.
