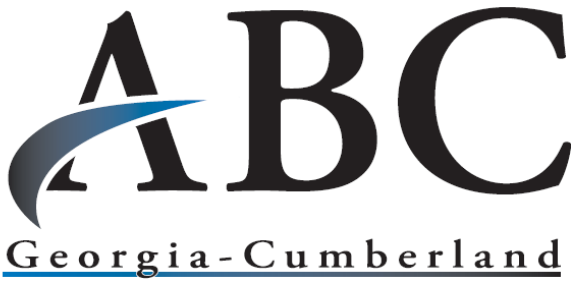
Announcements Continued
