Community Connection

When children are removed from their homes out of concern for their safety, they are usually brought to a child welfare services office to await placement. This wait can be a few hours to several days, even weeks or months at times. These children often have nothing with them and are scared, lonely, hungry, and in dirty clothing.

The Isaiah 117 House provides a comforting home where these children can be brought to wait – a place that is safe with friendly and loving volunteers who provide clean clothes, smiles, toys, and snuggly blankets. This space allows children to receive the comfort and care they need while child welfare staff can do the necessary paperwork and identify a good placement.

The mission of Isaiah 117 House is threefold:

- reduce trauma for children awaiting placement
- lighten the load for child welfare services
- ease the transition for foster care families

Our August Community Connection will be to collect arts and crafts activity kits for the children served at the Isaiah 117 House of a Knox County. You may choose to purchase these kits or contribute to Community Services and let us purchase the kits on your behalf. We will be gathering all the kits on Sabbath, August 19, and delivering them to the House staff shortly after.
