Our community focus for September is to raise \$500 for Project Linus. Last year, we collected fuzzy and warm blankets for the project. This time, they're asking us to help with shipping expenses.

What is Project Linus and why is it important?

Project Linus' mission is to "provide love, a sense of security, warmth and comfort to children who are seriously ill, traumatized, or otherwise in need through the gifts of new handmade blankets and afghans, lovingly created by volunteer "blanketeers."

They have let us know that there are many expenses involved in maintaining Project Linus. Normal expenses include fabric, batting, yarn, other blanket-making supplies, blanket labels, printing, office supplies, shipping, accounting, and auditing to name a few. With the increase in postal rates however, they need funds to help cover the shipping of blankets to children all around the United States. Project Linus is a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation.
